

Key Issues from the meeting held on Monday 18th July 2017



WILLASTON
Residents' and Countryside Society

Fields on Hooton Road/Heath Lane

Paul Jackson attended the meeting to discuss issues he had on his land on the corner of Hooton Road and Heath Lane. Following expressions of concern from residents, WR&CS asked the Planning Officers of CWaC to investigate the activities there. Paul has stopped using the exit onto Hooton Road and has been told by CWaC to submit a planning application for containers and surfacing on the Heath Lane entrance.

British Legion

The Willaston Services Club, which uses the Legion building and pays rent to them, will cease to operate in August. Several concerns were raised including the preservation of the hedging around the site, security when the site is not used, what will happen to the artefacts such as the Roll of Honour and the potential loss of a village facility. We have already been in contact with the Willaston branch of the Legion and will follow this up, along with contacting the Legion nationally.



Play Area

We will be working with the Council to install two further pieces of equipment in the play area – a roundabout and a wooden tractor. This will use money that we have raised and need to spend by end March 2018.

We will then do some fund-raising for the final piece of equipment we wish to install – a large climbing unit suitable for older children.



Memorial Hall

The Memorial Hall will be undergoing a programme of internal improvements this Summer. These include redecoration, new radiators, carpet and curtains. In addition, the sound system is being improved, Wi-Fi installed and the external CCTV improved.

Mobile Library

A six-month review of usage of the mobile library shows that there are now 20 visitors per session on average, whereas there were only 10 when the library was at the Methodist Church.
