You Said, We Did

Little Neston & Burton

You Said: Residents raised concerns of safety due to the way in which many parents were parking when dropping off and picking up their children from Woodfall Primary School.

We Did: Working in partnership with the staff and pupils at Woodfall Primary School and Chester West and Chester Road Safety team launched the 'Parking Charter'

This asks parents and carers to pledge a number of things that they will, or will not do during the school run, such as not dropping off on the yellow 'zig-zag' markings, not parking on pavements and parking courteously, leaving residential driveways clear.

Neston & Parkgate

You Said: Concern raised about speeding vehicles around the various locations within these community areas.

We Did: Speed enforcement and monitoring carried out at key locations raised by the community. Cheshire Highways have also deployed their speed monitoring devices to assist in compiling data to show non-compliance of local speed limits and so that we can deploy resources more effectively within these areas.

We continue to promote the 'Community Speed Watch' scheme to enable local residents to assist in playing a role in reducing speeding their local area.

Willaston, Thornton & Netherpool

You Said: Concerns were raised about the use and supply of drugs ay Gateacre Court.

We Did: Working with partnership agencies local officers executed a drugs warrant at the property. Two suspects were arrested, charged and remanded in custody.

They have since attended court and both received a combined prison sentence of 8 years.
